

IZIWINE Terms & Conditions

- . The present terms and conditions details obligations of all parties. The buyer is to agree to all conditions unconditionally. Iziwine reserves the right to change the terms and conditions when needed and to amend prices of its services at any time.
 - . The wines described on the order form are for personal use only. They have been acquired in France and will not under any circumstances be re-sold.
 - . By signing the order form, the buyer mandates Iziwine and its 3rd parties to perform everything necessary for the wines that the buyer has already purchased, to be delivered at the address designated by the buyer on his behalf and confirm to answer to any inquiries from an Iziwine third party in the country of destination to pay for tax / duties to have the wine delivered. In case of no answer, the wine will be sent back to the shipper at the consignee expense.
 - . The buyer accepts the price of the wine and the price of all the Iziwine services and declares to be aware of the following legal information: Alcohol abuse is damaging your health, to be consumed with moderation; alcohol is not to be consumed when pregnant; selling alcohol to underage is forbidden; the undersigning client certifies being of legal age and to have the legal capability to buy wine and have them delivered in France and in the country the wines are being shipped to.
 - . Iziwine and 3rd parties make no representation to the legal rights of any one to ship or import wine into any country and the buyer is the solely responsible for shipment of alcoholic beverage products and assumes all obligations for compliance with his country's law.
 - . Prices include VAT as applicable at time of purchase for France and intra Europe shipping. All wines to be shipped out of Europe may be sold without VAT. Excise tax, local tax, national tax and other duty related to the country of delivery are for the client to pay or a designated third party in case of gift. Exceptionally for USA and destination specifically mentioned on the Order Form, the wine is delivered Delivery Duty Paid (DDP) as Tax and processing cost are paid before the wine is shipped. Only for USA taxes and duty at arrival are included in the price of shipping. Regarding the wine delivered out of metropolitan France the prices listed does not include excise tax nor any other applicable tax.
 - . The buyer guarantees Iziwine to dispose of all necessary authorizations linked to the use of the present credit card. Iziwine reserves the right, either to contact the client using the phone number given above, or to ask for a copy of legal ID no matter the amount of the order.
 - . Any parcel sent back to the shipper due to an incorrect address is to be reshipped at the buyer's expense after confirmation of payment by the bank.
 - . Delivery may vary from 24 hours to two months depending on destination, document and administrative preparation, customs procedure. Also to be taken into account the delivery choices of the buyer on the order form. Iziwine can't be held responsible for extra delays resulting from customs or tax payments upon arrival.
 - . Under no circumstances can Iziwine be held responsible of any alleged alteration of the wine itself.
 - . Upon delivery, the recipient is to always check the inside of the package. If the bottles have been damaged, the seller is to refuse the parcel, and acknowledge the damage in written on the delivery slip (refused delivery due to damage or breakage). The buyer is to indicate on the delivery slip, written and signed reserves, any unconformity regarding the delivery (discrepancy between order form and delivery of the goods, damaged parcel, broken bottle...). This verification is considered done as soon as the buyer, or a personal legally able to receive alcohol and authorized by the buyer, has signed the delivery slip. The buyer is to inform Iziwine on the day of delivery or at the latest 24h after delivery of any claim and delivery errors and/or discrepancies in the bottles delivered. Any claim signaled after this delay will not be deemed valid.
 - . Any claims not signaled within the frame set above cannot be taken into account and the seller still takes no responsibility regarding the buyer.
 - . The compulsory Insurance mentioned on the Order Form is covering loss and breakage up to 24 000 € per shipment linked to the transport of the wine packed either in high quality standard styro packing for 6 bottles or specific carton delivered by Iziwine to the shop and no others. In case of proved loss or breakage accepted by Iziwine, Iziwine will buy the same wine from the shop and ship it back to the client. If the wine is not available, the shop will make a proposition of an equivalent type of wine to the client. In case the client refuses this offer, Iziwine will reimburse the client on the bases of the original invoice.
 - . Iziwine cannot be held responsible in the result of any circumstances arising, independent to the will of either party and impeaching the fulfillment of the contract.
 - . Shall any one of the present Terms and Conditions be considered invalid or declared as such by law, all the remaining Terms and Conditions will still apply.
 - . The ordering process implies the collection of various private information regarding the buyer. In accordance with the French law "informatique et liberté" 6 juin 1978, the buyer retains the right to access and rectify any of his personal information.
 - . The present terms and conditions are relevant to French law. Only the Terms and condition written in French will be referred to. In case of disagreement or claim, the buyer will first turn to Iziwine or the wine seller depending of the nature of the conflict, to seek a conflict resolution agreement. In any case only the French tribunals are deemed competent.
